In cooperation with gospel churches, ministers and like minded organizations, PRM is engaged in the sponsorship of orphanages and humanitarian assistance works in Cambodia and other Southeast Asian countries while continuing to explore opportunities to serve the needy in communities across the United States.

The work of PRM in Cambodia began with the establishment of our orphanage in Stoung, Kampong Thom Province in January 2008. Since its establishment, we have witnessed steady growth and a positive impact on the lives of both the children and the community in which they live.

Join with us as we look forward to seeing the scope of our impact increase through additional resources and community efforts.

- PRM is committed to increasing our efforts in Cambodia and Southeast Asia as opportunities are made available.
- Each effort is entered into with much prayer and a careful accounting of the costs.
- PRM is committed to ensuring that 100% of all contributions reach the intended recipients. Our U. S. staff are engaged on a voluntary basis only.
- The orphanage is staffed with teachers and directors who are Khmer and have an established history in the community in which they work.
- In addition to our sponsorship of the orphanage in Stoung, we are engaged in a variety of humanitarian efforts in Siem Reap Province and Pailin City.
- We have been committed to reducing costs wherever possible. With that in mind, we have operated the orphanage for the past two years in a leased facility. In the coming year, we hope to purchase land which will enable us to grow the facility as well as begin offering vocational and skills training to the students and community.

An orphan in Cambodian society is defined as *“a child who has been lost or abandoned by one or both parents, or whose parents have died.”* (As a matter of policy, PRM has limited admission to our facilities to those whose parents have both died.) Current estimates suggest a total of greater than 1,000,000 orphans are currently living in Cambodia with little hope of adequate nutrition, medicine, or education.

Orphans are commonly distributed to the care of relatives who often resent their presence and the unasked for burden that they represent to already limited and inadequate resources. Common results of these living arrangements include neglect, abuse, and severe malnutrition.

The widespread poverty of the Cambodian people has resulted in a burgeoning criminal element whose activities include a full range from petty theft, growth and distribution of marijuana and opiates to prostitution and child sex trafficking. Orphaned children who are fortunate enough to survive early childhood are preyed upon quite naturally by these criminal elements.

It is our belief that through the proper care of these children including the provision of a loving environment, proper nutrition, medicine, education (both Khmer and English), vocational training and a grounding in the Word of God and biblical principles of morality these children will be able to escape the cycle of violence and poverty to contribute positively to economic and spiritual prosperity of their nation.

- Pray for God’s blessing upon the children of Cambodia, that they may know Him and be strengthened in the power of His might.
- Pray for the establishment of additional facilities for the children in Varin, Siem Reap Province; and other areas as God directs.
- Pray for the government of Cambodia to relax restrictions upon the free exercise of religion and the oversight of charitable works.
- Pray for volunteers to assist in the establishment of vocational (agricultural, mechanical and IT) training programs at the orphanage facility.
- Pray for God’s continued direction of our efforts and for the wisdom to guide these efforts for His glory and for the good of His people.
- Pray for the people of Cambodia that their eyes may be opened and that they may escape the darkness of the idolatry that has enslaved them for so long.
